Leisure Link goes mobile

Leisure Link is a major player in the UK retail leisure market, operating over 90,000 pay-to-play machines in pubs, clubs, etc.

I2 Mobile (now Codegate) helped with the roll out of nearly 600 Psion mobile terminals to their cash collectors throughout the UK.

The cash collectors utilise the mobile terminals to plug into and extract data from amusement-with-prizes, juke boxes, casino, video and skill-based games machines. On arrival at the venue, after emptying the machine and counting the cash, the collector inputs the total cash take and the unit calculates the customer's allocation and issues a receipt.

Pendulum software and a TAAPS Comms Server were introduced to provide sophisticated data communications between the handhelds and head office.
