## Ticket validation 'front end' for Wembley

Wembley Stadium required a validation system for its extraordinary venue, to ensure that holders of duplicated or other fraudulent tickets cannot gain access to events and VIP areas.

Each ticket has a unique number represented by a barcode. When tickets "disappear" en route to their destinations, their numbers are marked as invalid in the database and replacements are produced with new numbers.

At the turnstile, or other entry point, each ticket is read and validated against the database by Motorola barcode scanners and mobile computers, using software developed by Codegate.
